



# U.S. Army PEO STRI STOC II

Awarded in January 2009, STOC II is a multiple-award ID/IQC with a \$17.5B ceiling structure that provides the Warfighter with the next generation of simulation and training devices to meet the challenges of the joint operational environment. STOC II is not only a continuation but an evolution of its predecessor, STOC I. The omnibus contracting vehicle awarded a total of 142 contracts spread over two lots: Lot I, Full and Open Lot (consisting of small and large businesses), and Lot II, Small Business Set-Aside. The NAICS code for the STOC II contracts is 333319.

The maximum period of performance for any delivery or task order is five years from the date of delivery or task order award. In essence, the Government may issue an order on the last day of the ordering period of the contract and have a period of performance extending up to five years.

## **MULTIPLE ORDER TYPES**

Delivery/task orders derived from the basic STOC II contracts may be any one or multiples of the following award types:

- Firm-Fixed Price (FFP)
- Cost-Plus-Fixed-Fee (CPFF)
- Cost- Plus-Award-Fee (CPAF)
- Time and Materials (T&M)

Individual delivery or task order may specify other contract types but must incorporate all applicable clauses into the delivery or task order.

## PEO STRI BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES PORTAL (STRI BOP)

The STRI BOP is an electronic information system PEO STRI developed to make new opportunities available to STOC II contractors early and to encourage electronic information exchanges with the Government. PEO STRI is updating STRI-BOP to include specific changes the award of the STOC II contract requires. This includes new templates for Sources Sought Notice (SSN) and Request for Information (RFI), among others. A new STOC II Contract Opportunity System (COS) is currently under construction and the Acquisition Center expects its deployment in the November 2009 timeframe. The CIO will integrate the STOC II COS with the PEO STRI Enterprise Business System (EBS).
